THE PAPERS

Fifteen papers, every one on a problem you have already met — or soon will. The speakers, an expert international panel of practitioners and authors, are to be announced shortly.

1. **The Russian price cap, in plain terms — what the regime actually requires, and how to stay the right side of it.**
2. **Compliance when the position is genuinely unclear — how to make a decision at the moment of fixture that you can defend later.**
3. **The regulatory perimeter of a tanker voyage — where the sanctions and anti-corruption lines really bite.**
4. **The defensible record — the file that stands up when both an arbitrator and a regulator read it.**
5. **Designated entities and ownership opacity — the vessel that is clean on the surface but not beneath it.**
6. **Nomination under stress — substitution, narrowing laycans, and a counterparty designated overnight.**
7. **War risk in practice — the calls the operator has to make, and the file to keep, when the next crisis hits.**
8. **Additional war-risk premium — who pays, how it cascades, and what happens when it doubles mid-voyage.**
9. **Legitimate and illegitimate voyage orders — when a master can lawfully refuse, and the right to check first.**
10. **Demurrage as the remedy for delay — what the rate really carries, and the new costs now pressing on it.**
11. **AI along the demurrage claim — where the money leaks, and the checks that catch it before settlement.**
12. **Bill of lading issuance in the tanker trade — who drafts it, who dates it, who signs it, and the risk in each.**
13. **Possession without paper — electronic bills of lading, and why the wet trades still run on paper.**
14. **Who pays for the EUA? — EU ETS, FuelEU Maritime and CII, and where the carbon cost lands.**
15. **The trading landscape — a supply shock, tonne-miles and freight, and what it means for the fleet.**

WHAT YOU WALK AWAY WITH

The confidence to explain the price cap in a sentence and stay the right side of it. A clear answer on when a master can refuse an order — and how to back it. A grip on what the demurrage rate carries, and where the new costs of a voyage now bite. The judgement to read an ownership structure that looks clean but is not. And a record that holds when both an arbitrator and a regulator come looking.
